Below you will find the assignments that your child will need to complete for the Digital Learning Day. Each section will be geared towards a different subject.

Reading:

- 1. Have your child log into their DCSS Portal (their username and password should be the same. First initial and last initial and their student number. **Example: hm12345**)
- 2. They will need to click on the Classworks icon
 - a. From there, there will be 4 boxes that pop up on their screen. They will need to click the blue button that says "Begin an Assignment"
 - b. They will then click on the Language Arts button to start working on their Individualized Learning Plan.
 - c. Have them work on this plan for 30-45 minutes. (This plan is based on STAR testing and has them working on skills that they need some extra practice on)

*If for any reason your child is having a difficult time with the games (sometimes they aren't the best), please send your child's teacher a dojo and we can turn it off for them.

*They will have to listen to instructions on the games, so they will need to be able to hear the sound on the computer for those.

- 3. After your child has completed their Classworks time, your child will log on to Google Classroom and complete the Readworks passage that is assigned to them.
- 4. The assignment will be on their Reading Google Classroom (it is the green colored classroom)
 - a. It will be under the topic: Friday, January 13th Digital Learning Day
- 5. They will complete the assignment and turn it in on Readworks

Math:

If your child has Mrs. Scales for math, this is what they will complete:

- 1. Your child will log into Prodigy
 - a. They will work on Prodigy Math for 30 minutes
- 2. After that 30 minutes is up, they will then log into the DCSS Portal and click on the Classworks icon.
 - a. They will click on the blue button that says "Begin an Assignment"
 - b. They will then click on the math button to work on their Individualized Learning Plan for math.
 - c. They will work on those assignments for 30 minutes.

*If for any reason your child is having a difficult time with the games (sometimes they aren't the best), please send your child's teacher a dojo and we can turn it off for them.

*They will have to listen to instructions on the games, so they will need to be able to hear the sound on the computer for those.

If your child has Mrs. Smith for math, this is what they will complete:

- 1. Your child will log in to Reflex Math.
 - a. They will work on Reflex for 30 minutes
- 2. After that 30 minutes is up, they will then log into the DCSS Portal and click on the Classworks icon.
 - a. They will click on the blue button that says "Begin an Assignment"
 - b. They will then click on the math button to work on their Individualized Learning Plan for math.
 - c. They will work on those assignments for 30 minutes.

*If for any reason your child is having a difficult time with the games (sometimes they aren't the best), please send your child's teacher a dojo and we can turn it off for them.

*They will have to listen to instructions on the games, so they will need to be able to hear the sound on the computer for those.

Writing:

- 1. Your child will log into their Google Classroom and find their ELA/Writing Google Classroom (The classroom is purple)
- 2. Your child will find the topic: Friday, January 13th Digital Learning Day
- 3. Your child will click on the assignment labeled "Friday Writing Assignment" under the topic and click on the Google Document that is attached to the assignment.
- 4. They will follow the prompt that is on the document and use the document to type out their writing
- 5. After they are done writing, they will turn in the assignment on Google Classroom.
 - a. To turn in an assignment, they will go back to the Classwork tab and click the assignment to expand the box
 - b. Once the assignment box is expanded, then they will click on "View Assignment"
 - c. It will bring up a separate page and they will click on the "Turn In" or "Submit" button the upper right hand side of the screen.

Science:

- 1. Your child will go to their Science Google Classroom (The classroom color is purple)
- 2. They will go under the topic: Friday, January 13th Digital Learning Day
- 3. They will click on the "Habitats Choice Board" assignment under that topic.
- 4. They will choose 2 things from that choice board to complete.
 - a. Some of them will have QR codes to scan to access things
 - b. They can be any 2 off the board, they don't have to be in a certain order
- 5. Anything they complete on paper from the choice board can be turned in on <u>Tuesday</u>. <u>January 17th</u> when we return to school.

Social Studies:

- Your child will log into their Social Studies Google Classroom (it's an orange/yellow classroom)
- 2. Your child will find the topic: Friday, January 13th Digital Learning Day
- 3. They will click on the "Native American Choice Board" and choose 2 things to do from the choice board
 - a. They can be any 2 off the board, they don't have to be in a certain order
- 4. Any papers that they complete from the board can be turned in on <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>January</u> 17th when we return to school.

If you happen to lose power and don't have internet access for your child to complete the online assignments, have your child complete the packet that went home.

Most of the things in the packet are assigned online (with the exception of math)
